### How many scholarships?

*One or several scholarships (at the sole discretion of the CESC), with a minimum payout of €5,000 per scholarship awarded. The scholarships are direct contributions to the tuition fee payable for the MMH program intake in fall 2020. ### Who is eligible?

- *hospitality industry professionals living and working in the EMEA Region*
- *interested in becoming actively involved in the Cornell Hotel Society (CHS)*
- *committed to become a member of the CHS (upon completion of the MMH program)*
- *with a strong desire to contribute to the development and growth of the hospitality industry in the EMEA Region*
- *applications by candidates not holding a degree from The Hotel School will be considered with preference*

### How to apply?

*- candidates shall send their application to the President of the respective CHS Chapter (see contact information below), (1) including a motivational letter outlining as to how the candidate intends to contribute to the CHS as well as the development and growth of the hospitality industry, (2) a recommendation letter by the Chapter President or – in case the Chapter President does not know the candidate personally – a recommendation letter by a CHS Member AND/OR some hospitality industry top executive who does so, AS WELL AS (3) an up-to-date CV by the candidate, by 22 May 2020*

# EMEA MMH Scholarship Fund

## MMH Scholarship 2020

*- upon receipt of the nominations within the deadline, the CESC (i.e. an appointed sub-committee) will evaluate the eligibility of the candidates (residence in the EMEA Region, CHS and hospitality industry aspirations, recommendation/referral, motivational letter); the candidates shall be informed about the outcome of their applications by the end of June 2020*

*- the MMH scholarship recipients will then be asked to provide evidence of their successful enrolment for the fall 2020 intake; the scholarship will be directly credited towards the first tranche of the tuition fee; this scholarship may be combined with other scholarships available to candidates from the EMEA Region (for further information, please feel free to contact the CESC)*

### How is the scholarship scheme funded?

*- as is done every year, the scheme has been proposed by the CESC and approved by the membership attending the CHS EMEA Regional Meeting Cannes 2019*

*- the scholarships are financed by the EMEA MMH Scholarship Fund; the Fund receives proceeds from the EMEA Region's scholarship auctions as well as direct gifts from EMEA Chapters, alumni and other supporters*
